One of the most popular grapes from the Bordeaux region, Merlot grapes well deserve their international reputation. This typical Merlot wine is big and aggressive, yet pure, with almost distilled-fruit tastes. Remarkable character, with pure, clean berry tastes. Massive, yet with plenty of structure. This generic wine, made from a mono varietals grape is easy to drink and enjoyable at any moment.

Powerful and deep, with superb middle for the vintage. Roasted aromas of crystallized black raspberry and tar. Finishes with substantial tongue-dusting tannins and excellent persistence.

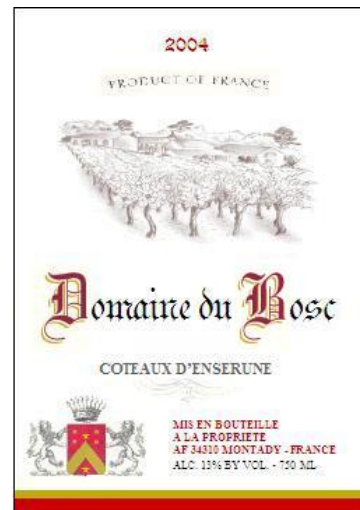

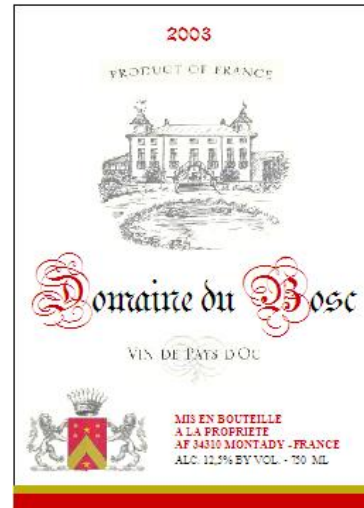

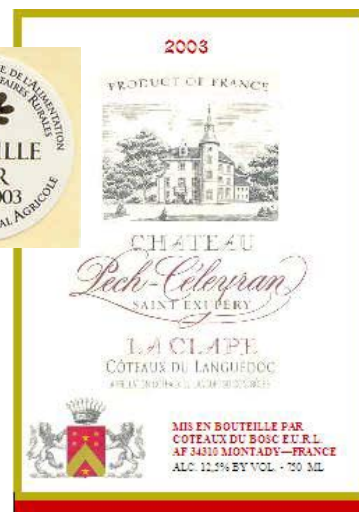

A more complexe wine, made with the assembly of various cépages.
With a very strong influence of the Mediterranean Sea and sun and a clay-limestone soil, La Clape terroir produces unique and exquisite wines. The surrounding garrigue and pine forest greatly influences the wine aromatic composition. Its bouquet is adorned with the scents of vegetal such as mint and wild flowers, as well as red fruits like cassis and raspberry. The yield is limited to 50 HL per hectare in order to concentrate the best of the grapes in each bottle.

The southern exposure of the vines combined with the calcareous-clay soil make an other unique terroir. Traditional techniques, yet in a very modern cellar, are carefully followed from many generations in order to maintain the quality of the wine. Very fruity and rich, this wine is easy and pleasant to drink.

This speciality wine is very different from all others in our selection. The sémillon grapes, extremely matured, are harvested very late in the season in order to maximize the sweetness and the alcohol. Very nice yellow color with gold touch. After revealing strong aromas of white flowers and dry fruits, you will discover some taste of honey and dry fig. An excellent selection to drink as an appetizer, with a foie gras (pate), with a desert or after dinner.
